**Notch Example Cases**

**Example 1**

NCP income \$22,209.53

CP income \$60,000.00

1 child.

NCP claims the child.

All other settings default.

Look at Analysis Page

Compare to the Guidelines tables.

See the red warning of low income notch.

NOTE that the support obligation is \$370.00 per month plus \$92.54 in cash med for a total of \$462.54 per month. Increase NCP income by one cent.

Support went down from \$80 per month when NCP's income went up by one cent.

**Example 2:**

2 kids for support.

NCP Income \$30,230.57  
CP at \$60,000.00  
Each claims 1 child.  
All other settings default.

Support is at \$705 plus \$126 for cash med for a total of \$830 per month. Add one cent to NCP income.

Support and cash med went down to a total of \$632 per month even though NCP income went up by one cent. \$200 per month downward as NCP income went up one penny.

**Example 3:**

3 Children for support.

NCP income \$34,730.82  
CP income \$60,000  
NCP Claims 1 – CP Claims 2

Support is \$933 plus \$145 for cash med for a total of \$1,078 per month.

Increase NCP by one penny.

Support is now \$643 plus \$145 cash med for a total of \$788 per month.

A difference of \$290 per month.

KEY – look out for the shaded areas – low-income parties.
